### Notes

There is an application fee of AED 500 per student, payable at the time of registration. This fee is non-refundable.

There is a registration deposit of 10% of the annual fees payable on acceptance of place to secure the seat. This deposit is non-refundable (as per the KHDA Registration and Refund Policy). The deposit is deducted from the fees for the first term.

Sibling discount is applicable from date of entry to the school.

Fees for admission during the school year will be based on 10 months pro-rated on the annual fee.

If a student is enrolled from the beginning of term but chooses to join the school at a later date, the fees are due from the date of enrollment.

Tuition fees do not include charges for external examinations, uniform, transport, extra-curricular activities, educational and non-educational trips and similar activities.
